Green leaves that rhyme with golly.

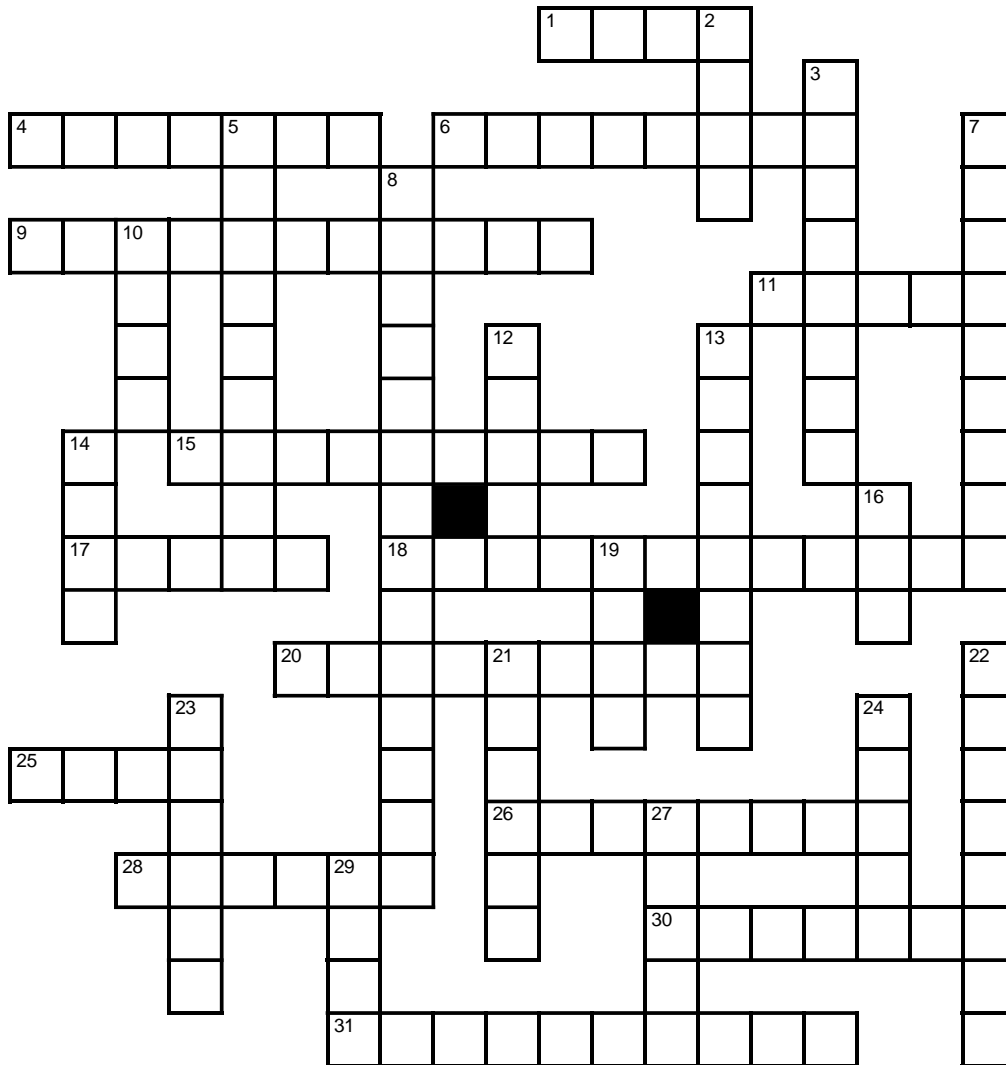
